All players, parents and coaches are expected to abide by the Club's Code of Conduct which forms part of the registration form. Please make sure that you are familiar with its contents and signed by both player and a parent. It is designed to provide a positive experience for your child from all involved with the club.

SEASON DATES - Begins 1st week of Term 2 2018 & concludes at the end of Term 3, 2018.

ADMISSION AT VENUES is \$2.50 for all players and spectators (under 12 spectators free) If you are going from venue to venue on the same day, ask the door keeper for a GEBC stamp so you only pay one admission charge.

SCORESHEET FEES at all venues is \$37 per team which is divided up between the players. Usually \$6 or \$7 is collected from each player each week by the Team Manager to pay for the scoresheet. Any excess collected is put into a team kitty and used for an end of season function, free game, etc. as decided by the team.

GAME TIME – Games are played on Saturdays between 8:15am and 8:00pm with times allocated in order of increasing age (ie: Under 8's play earliest, Under 23's play latest). Please arrive at your game 10 – 15 minutes prior to start time so you have time to stretch and warm up. Please ensure your child brings a named drink bottle to each game.

SCORING – Each team has to provide a scorer for each game. Every family is expected to take their turn at scoring usually arranged by the Team Manager drawing up a roster. Scoring is not difficult. If you don't know how, ask the Team Manager to sit with you and show you. Scoring is now done via a touch screen at the main venues or a laptop at satellite (school) venues. If you are rostered on to score but are unable to attend, please arrange a swap or advise your Team Manager.

PLAYER QUALIFICATION – Players must play a minimum of 50% of regular season games (including grading games) to qualify for finals.

FIRST GOAL CERTIFICATES. When the younger players score their first goal in basketball, let the Team Manager know so they can notify the club and a laminated first goal certificate will be produced for your child. We generally suggest that these certificates be given to the schools (without the child knowing) so that they can present them to the child during assembly (or other). This makes it that little more special.

TROPHIES AND TEAM PHOTOS - Trophies are awarded for participation to Under 8, 10 and 12's. Team photos are taken each season and are given free to Under 14's and above in lieu of a trophy. Photos for 8, 10 & 12's are minimal cost, currently \$15.

TRAINING – Each team will have a weekly training session of at least 45 minutes duration. Current training days and venues are

Exact training times per team are determined once coaches are appointed and are often influenced by their availability. In principle, younger age groups will train earlier than older age groups. Please ensure your child brings a named basketball and a drink bottle.

FEES – Are due and payable at time of registration. Please post to P.O. Box 2260, North Ringwood or Direct Debit to our account (Details below). If you have hardships, the club is willing to listen and accommodate where possible. See the Registration Secretary or Treasurer to discuss.

If paid by first game of the season
\$75.00 for 1st child in the family
\$55.00 for each child thereafter

If paid after first game of the season
\$80.00 for 1st child in the family
\$60.00 for each child thereafter

If fees are not paid by the end of grading games (usually round 8), your child/ren will not be allowed to continue to play due to insurance restrictions.

Teams:

Determined by age as at 31st December 2017
Age Groups are Under 8, 10,12, 14, 16, 18 & U23.
Recommended Minimum Age: Children turn 7 prior to start of the season

Team Selection:

Every effort is made to put players into suitable teams. Factors considered in this process include age, skill level, friendship groups, team number balancing, parent special requests along with input from coaches and age group co-ordinators. It should be noted that whilst special requests are endeavoured to be accommodated, no guarantees are given in this regard. Any changes to teams after they have been formally announced is generally only done so with the consent of the coaches and parents directly affected.
